



# **Happy Hearts Blanket**

Finished Size: 43" wide x 39" long

#### Materials



**Deborah Norville Collection:** Serenity Sport Weight

300-01 White (Color A) — 2 balls 300-12 Pink (Color B) — 2 balls 300-33 Kiwi (Color C) — 2 balls 300-23 Aqua (Color D) — 2 balls

Crochet hook: US G-6 (4.25mm) Extras: Markers, yarn needle

#### Gauge

18 dc and 9 rows = 4"; Motif = 8" wide x 7" long. Use any size hook necessary to obtain the specified gauge.

## Abbreviations

ch(s) - chain(s)

cm - centimeter(s)

dc - double crochet(s)

dec - decrease(s)

**mm** - millimeters

sc - single crochet(s)

sk – skip

sl st - slip stitch

sp(s) - space(s)

st(s) - stitch(es)

[] – repeat the instructions inside the brackets the number of times specified.

## **Special Stitches**

Shell – (Dc, ch 1, dc) in st indicated.

# **Special Abbreviations:**

Dc2tog (double crochet 2 stitches together) – [Yo, insert hook in next st and pull up a loop, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] twice, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook (dec 1 st).

Dc3tog (double crochet 3 stitches together) – [Yo, insert hook in next st and pull up a loop, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook (dec 2 sts).

Scatog (single crochet 2 stitches together) – Pull up a loop in each of next 2 stitches, yo and draw yarn through all 3 loops on hook (dec 1 st).

**Sc3tog (single crochet 3 stitches together)** – Pull up a loop in each of next 3 stitches, yo and draw yarn through all 4 loops on hook (dec 2 sts).



# Pattern Note

Ch 3 counts as one dc throughout pattern.

# Motif (Make 36, 9 each in colors A, B, C, and D)

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 4, 2 dc in fourth ch from hook; turn -3 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in each of first 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc; turn – 5 dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in each offirst 2 dc, shell in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in last dc; turn – 8 dc.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in first dc and in each dc across to ch-1 sp, dc in ch-1 sp, mark last st made as center, dc in each dc across to last dc, 2 dc in last dc;

turn – 11 dc. **Row 5:** Ch 3, dc in first dc and in each dc to marked dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in marked dc, dc in each dc across to last dc, 2 dc in last dc; turn – 14 dc.

**Rows 6-8:** Repeat Rows 4 and 5 once, then repeat Row 4 one more time – 23 dc.

Row 9: Ch 3, dc in first dc, ch 1, [dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc] 5 times, (dc, ch 1, dc) in marked st, [ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc] 5 times, ch 1, 2 dc in last dc; turn – 16 dc and 13 ch-1 sps.

**Row 10:** Ch 3, dc in first dc and in each dc and ch-1 sp across to last dc, 2 dc in last dc; turn – 31 dc.

**Row 11:** Ch 3, sk first dc, dc in next 14 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc, dc in next dc and in each dc across; turn – 32 dc.

## **Upper Left**

**Row 12:** Ch 3, sk first dc, [dc2tog] twice, dc in each of next 9 dc, dc2tog; turn, leaving remaining sts unworked – 13 sts.

Row 13: Ch 3, sk first dc, dc2tog, dc in each of next 6 dc, [dc2toq] twice; turn – 10 sts.

**Row 14:** Ch 3, sk first dc, [dc2tog] twice, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc2tog; turn – 7 sts.

**Row 15:** Ch 3, sk first dc, [dc2tog] 3 times; turn -4 sts.

Row 16: Ch 3, sk first dc, dc3tog; fasten off.

# **Upper Right**

Row 12: With WS facing, join yarn with a sl st in next dc on Row 11; ch 3, sk first dc, dc2tog, dc in each of next 9 dc, [dc2tog] twice; turn – 13 sts.

**Row 13:** Ch 3, sk first dc, [dc2tog] twice, dc in each of next 6 dc, dc2tog; turn – 10 sts.

Row 14: Ch 3, sk first dc, dc2tog, dc in each of next 3 dc, [dc2tog] twice; turn – 7 sts.

Row 15: Ch 3, sk first dc, [dc2tog] 3 times; turn – 4 sts. Row 16: Ch 3, sk first dc, dc3tog; turn, do not fasten off.

# **Edging**

Ch 1, work 10 sc evenly spaced across to ch-1 sp on Row 11, sl st in ch-1 sp, [work 10 sc evenly spaced across to next point, 3 sc in point] twice, [work 20 sc evenly spaced to next point, 3 sc in point] twice, work 10 sc evenly spaced across to last point, 3 sc in point; join with a sl st to first sc; fasten off.

## Finishing

Referring to Assembly Diagram for placement, with RS facing, whipstitch motifs together working through both loops of both pieces, forming 6 vertical strips of 6 motifs each. With RS facing, whipstitch strips together in same manner.


## **Outer Edging**

Rnd 1: With RS facing, join Color A with a sl st in center sc of any point; ch 1, 3 sc in same point, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in center sc of each point and working sc2tog at each joining; join with a sl st in first sc; fasten off.

Rnd 2: With RS facing, join Color B with a sl st in center sc of any point; ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in center sc of each point, and working sc3tog at each inner corner; join with a sl st in first sc; fasten off.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2 with Color C. Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 2 with Color D.

Weave in ends.





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
